Two constitutional amendments will be on the November 8 ballot that would:

- **Put politicians in charge of public schools**, taking power away from experts, parents, voters, and local school boards.
- **Take money away from education** and public services, such as police, fire, and emergency services, and give the money to out-of-state corporations.
- If Amendments 2 & 4 pass, **West Virginia families have less say over their children's education** and have less funds to invest in public safety, healthcare, and infrastructure.

AMENDMENT 2 WOULD:

- **Would eliminate up to \$346 million** in funds that pay for public schools, police, firefighters, EMTs, buses and libraries.
- **Take power away from local communities** and put it into the hands of politicians in Charleston.
- **Eliminate protections for local services** in the state constitution to make way for tax giveaways to out-of-state corporations.

AMENDMENT 4 WOULD:

- **Put politicians in control** of our children's education, over the input of education experts and parents.
- **Force a one-size-fits-all educational framework** that would harm our schools.
- **Open the door to book banning** and other political stunts.
